- The Global Engagement Strategy is the **key element** of the USC's vision and mission.
- USC started on a comprehensive five-year international strategy. Since then our international approach has evolved to involve the concept of global engagement, a concept which is reflected in the <u>Egyptian political</u> <u>strategy</u>.
- USC collaborates with partners across the world to produce ground-breaking research, deliver innovative teaching, and to create opportunities for <u>students and</u> <u>staff</u> to gain international experience.



- The expansion and the enhancement of our <u>international</u> <u>networks</u> at the heart of the University's approach to internationalization, reflecting the opportunities and challenges of a dynamic global higher education landscape.
- We benefit from a rich mix of <u>international partnerships</u> of diverse kinds, some recent, some very longstanding. Our relationships with Gulf area, for example, date back before leaving Menofya University.
- We place particular emphasis on providing study and other international opportunities for USC students to ensure that we provide an environment where our students can learn and develop the skills and knowledge necessary to achieve success in the global economy.

• The promotion of opportunities for students to engage with language learning.

• The development of outward mobility and international experience opportunities for USC students, including short-term and longer term study abroad activity, and overseas work placements.
